Your landlord has started a court case to evict you. The court has scheduled a hearing for your case. The court may decide if you need to move out at this hearing. **Here are some things you can do BEFORE YOUR COURT DATE**:

Act

Do not ignore your eviction case. Go to court for all your hearings.

If you do not do anything, you will probably lose your case.



But you have options:

- Talk to your landlord and try to work out an agreement, or
- Move out and tell your landlord that you moved out, and
- Tell the judge your side.
