Looking up a Court Case

Overview

Commonly referred to as **CCAP**, the Wisconsin Circuit Court Access website is a free and convenient tool that people can use to find public court cases. An eviction case becomes a public record as soon as the case is filed.

Summary

Step 1	Search wicourts.gov
Step 2	At the top of the page, hover over Case Search and select Circuit Court.
Step 3	On the following page, with the heading Access to the Public Records of the Wisconsin Circuit Courts, click I Agree.
Step 4	Case Search Find a case using personal information. Only a Last Name is required, but entering First Name or County will give more specific results. Or If you are looking for a specific case and have the case number, enter the case number.
Step 5	Relevant Case Information <ul style="list-style-type: none">○ Filing Date○ Case Type: Small claims, traffic, etc.○ Case Status: Open/closed○ Plaintiff/Defendant information○ Court Record: Timeline of court dates, what happened, and record of documents filed in the case○ Civil Judgment: Information on amounts of any money judgements applied to the case
