Talk to an attorney about your restraining order case

Sojourner Family Peace Center is partnering with community attorneys to provide FREE brief legal assistance to victims of domestic abuse seeking restraining orders at the Milwaukee County Circuit Court. The consultations are intended to explain the legal process of the upcoming hearing, and to answer any questions a survivor may have about preparing for and participating in the hearing.

WHO: Petitioners for domestic abuse restraining orders who have upcoming hearings and want a more permanent restraining order at Milwaukee County Circuit Court.

WHAT: Free 20 minute telephone conference with a volunteer attorney about an upcoming injunction hearing. This is not legal representation for your hearing. It is legal advice prior to your hearing.

WHEN: Tuesdays, between 1:00 to 4:00 p.m.

HOW: Call the volunteer attorney hotline at 414-207-9601. If the attorney does not immediately answer on Tuesdays between 1:00-4:00pm, it is because they are speaking with another petitioner. Please hang up and call back later in the time period.
